<p>ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES</p> <p>This position provides direct instruction in English Language Acquisition for beginner/intermediate and/or advanced level classes two to four mornings a week at our Denver-Curtis Park location and oversees student work in the Burlington English platform. Classes are Monday & Wednesday mornings (Beginner/Intermediate) from 9:30 am – 12:00 pm and Tuesday & Thursday mornings (Advanced) from 9:30 am – 12:00 pm. There is an average of 2-4 hours per month for meetings and professional development. Prep time, meetings, and PD are paid. Additional duties include tracking student attendance and progress, administering standardized testing, reporting data into state database system, supervising classroom volunteers, attending meetings, and participating in professional development.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide direct instruction and 1:1 tutoring four mornings a week to students studying English as a Second Language using the Ventures curriculum and Burlington English learning platform. • Assist students in creating individualized education plans that meet their learning needs and goals. • Strive for 75% or better retention, maintain good communication with students and collaborate with Program Manager on student progress. 			



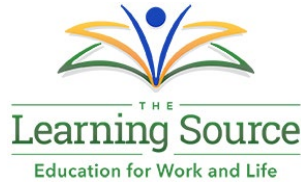
- Work toward requirement of 40% of all learners achieving a skill level gain measured from pre-test to post-test.
- Engage students with a range of skill levels using a variety of proven teaching skills and motivation strategies while meeting the needs of individual learning styles.
- Administer a variety of formative assessments and solicit regular student feedback to monitor student learning.
- Assist with orientation and Pre- and post-testing students using CASAS assessment.
- Oversee volunteer tutors and provide assistance regarding curriculum, teaching methods, and materials.
- Monitor time spent and progress on asynchronous learning students participate in on Burlington English.
- Implement core curricula, Ventures, tailored to English Language Acquisition.
- Perform daily record-keeping and data reporting responsibilities to The Learning Source. Track student progress, attendance, and outcomes.
- Attend Professional Development trainings, workshops, and required team meetings as assigned by The Learning Source.
