## INTERVIEWING SKILLS



The purpose of a resume is to get you an interview and the purpose of an interview is to land the next job in your career!

This week's topic is how to approach and consider some of the most basic and most often asked interview questions:

1. "Tell me a little about yourself"
2. "What is your biggest strength/weakness?"
3. "Do you have any questions for us?"

Always have questions during your interview. Make sure to do research on the company before the interview. Know common information: year they were founded, mission statement, size of the company. One good question is to ask about the potential for growth. Can you move up with the company? Ask what they believe is the best thing about the company. As always, trust your feeling about your interview experience. Remember: you are there to interview them, just as much as they are there to interview you. Look for a good fit for both sides!
