Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Student Success Coach is an integral member of the student services team, working with the Lead Success Coach and other Program Managers to assist students in identifying their educational goals and dreams, and creating support systems to increase learner retention and outcomes. This position provides a hybrid of case management and system navigation for program participants primarily in the Boulder County Workforce Region. Primary responsibilities include:

- Working with The Learning Source instructional team to identify learners that would benefit from 1:1 coaching and support
- Utilizing motivational interviewing techniques to help learners set individual goals and develop learning plans
- Address barriers that learners face in accomplishing goals or creating personal change and developing strategies to overcome these challenges.
- Facilitate workshops and focus groups on learning topics such as study skills and developing a Growth Mindset
- Maintaining up-to-date data to track and communicate student progress and learner outcomes during monthly meetings
- Providing back-up support with student enrollment and assessment processes in accordance with grant requirements
- Assisting instructors with analyzing test scores for learner placement in classes and in developing learning plans
- Performing daily record-keeping and data reporting responsibilities to The Learning Source. Utilizing standardized forms and processes to track student progress, attendance, and outcomes.
- Attending monthly staff meetings and Professional Development trainings as assigned by The Learning Source
- Other duties as assigned.
